4 FIRST-AID MEASURES

GENERAL INFORMATION

Do not breathe vapour/spray. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of accident or if you feel unwell, seek medical advice immediately (show label where possible).

INHALATION

EXTINGUISHING MEDIA

Fire can be extinguished using: Water spray, carbon dioxide, dry powder or polar resistant foam.

SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURES

Keep up-wind to avoid fumes.

SPECIFIC HAZARDS

Avoid breathing fire vapours. In case of fire, toxic gases may be formed.

PROTECTIVE MEASURES IN FIRE

Self contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing must be worn in case of fire.

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS

PROCESS CONDITIONS

Provide eyewash, quick drench.
